# Impact – Hawkesbury Nepean

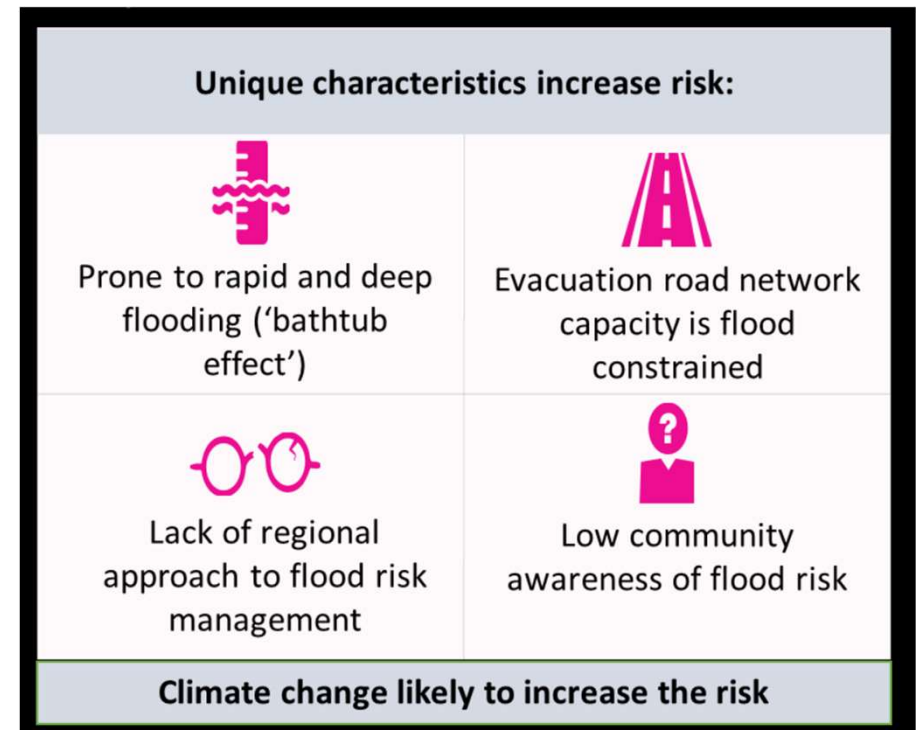
Tributaries:

# Emergency Risk – Hawkesbury Nepean

- **Prone to flooding due to the geography**
- **Flood plain**
- **Limited Evacuation pathways**
- **She'll be right attitude**
- **Low awareness of risk –**
- it is not a 1:100 YEAR, BUT a **1:100 CHANCE** each year



# Evacuation planning & COVID

## Planning assumptions

- **Must be a last resort**
- **Maximise notice of evacuation centre requirement**
- **Encourage self reliance in public messaging**
- **Establishment of an evacuation assistance Hotline**
- **Must meet the health guidelines**
- **Screening on arrival**
- **Cleaning processes**
