

The example of electricity exports

- With some of the best renewable energy resources in the world, Australia can be a large renewable exporter.
- Australia's renewable electricity exports could help to deepen our relationships with key countries in Asia, which are vital for achieving our broader foreign policy objectives.
- Concerns about the potential for electricity cut-offs to be used as a geopolitical weapon are likely to be minimal.
