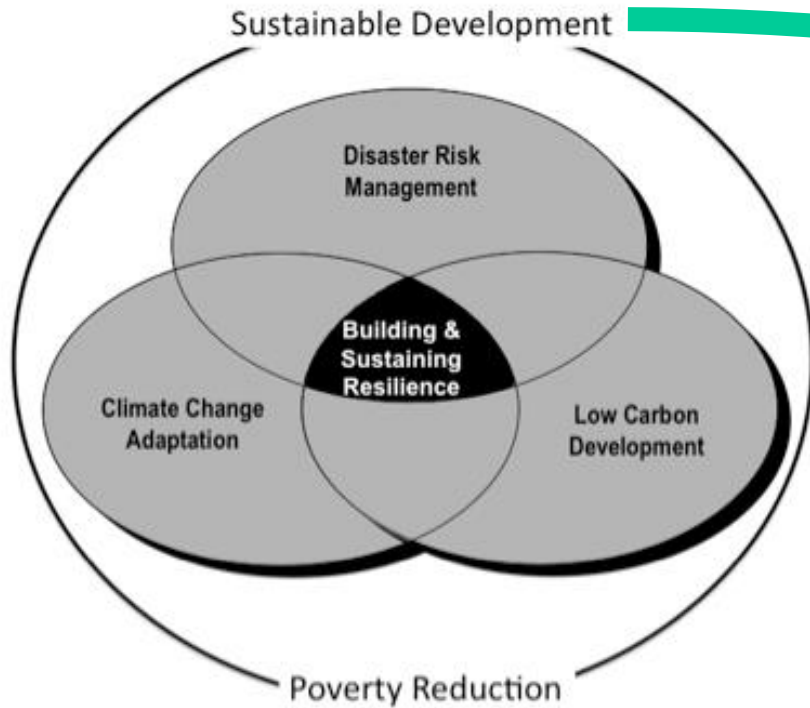

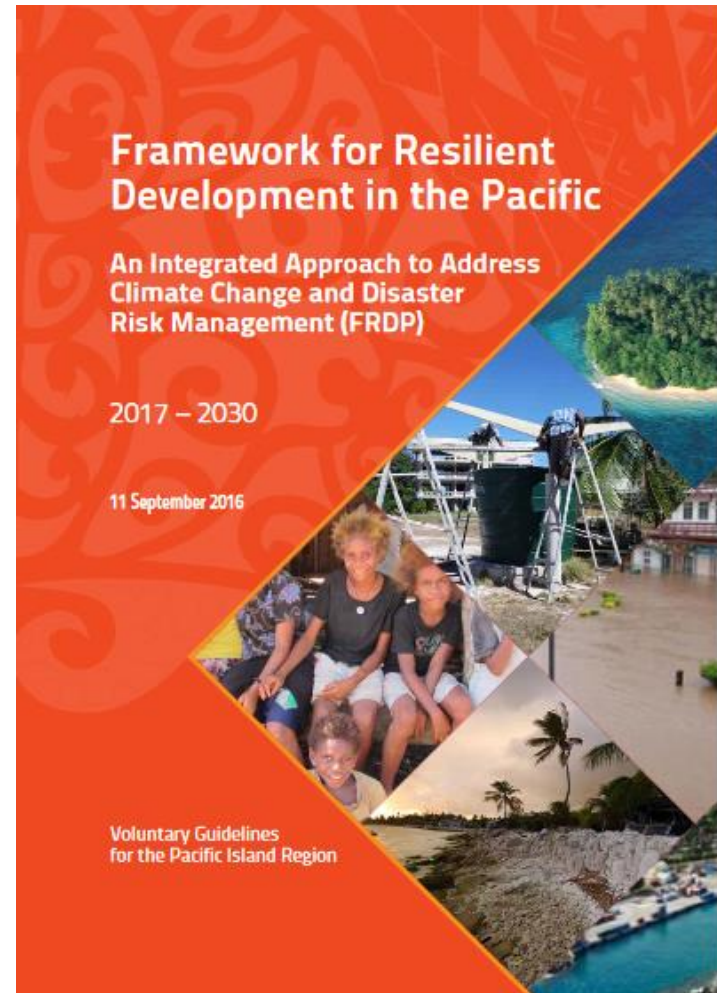

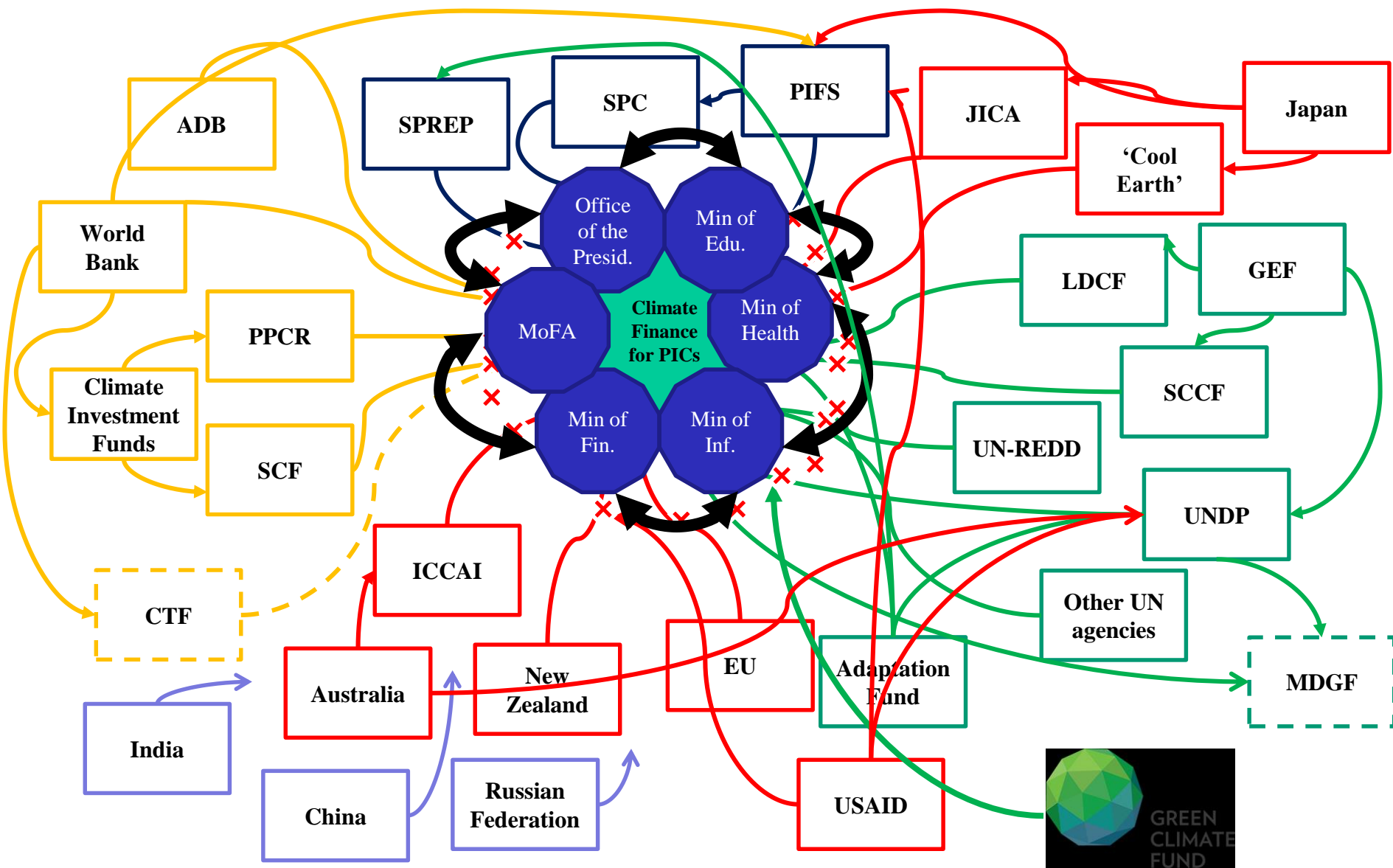


Framework for Resilient Development in the Pacific

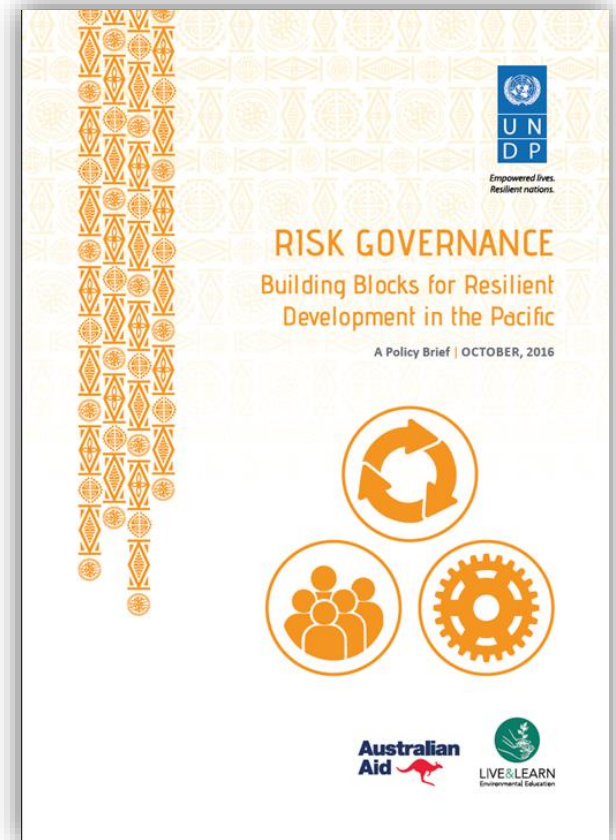
